Whether for parents, donors, volunteers or staff, we'll offer talks that connect, educate and uplift.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Do you offer education and training during the visit?

Absolutely. We can lead sessions on topics such as fundraising, work program, culture, residential, enterprise development, leadership and team building – all through a faith-based lens that keeps God at the core of our mission.

2. Can you speak to our community or donors?

3. What is the fee for a site visit?

Terms Defined

1. The Brookwood Way®

We refer to Brookwood's culture-in-action as *The Brookwood Way*®..... the invisible, secret sauce rooted in faith, dignity, purpose, and community. It is how Citizens and Community Members work, how we treat one another, and live out our mission every day.

2. Citizens

We refer to the adults with disabilities who live and work at Brookwood as *Citizens*. They are the heart of Brookwood, vessels through whom the Lord teaches us daily, reminding us that we learn far more from them than they ever learn from us.

3. Community Members

Our Community Members are the staff who live out *The Brookwood Way*® each day, forming the interconnected community that makes our mission possible. As members of one body, we work in an interdependent relationship supporting, learning from, and relying on one another to create a place where our Citizens can thrive.

4. Community Builders

We refer to participants in our Brookwood Way Conference and Center for Learning Offerings as *Community Builders*—those who are actively shaping purposeful communities across the street or across the world.
